The abstract should be of 200-450 words

The abstract should align to the abstract competition themes mentioned in the email.

The participant should provide the below **mentioned fields while submitting their abstract** through email:

- Scope and objective of the abstract (25-75 words)
- Approach and methodology including the process/procedures adopted (75-100 words)
- Results, observations and conclusion of abstract (100-200 words)
- Potential value-add enabled by the abstract in providing novel or additional information to the existing application or literature (25-75 words)

The jury will conduct the evaluation of the white paper based on specified guidelines.

04

Post evaluation, the selected candidates will be informed to prepare presentation for the conclave. Details on presentation guidelines will be shared later.

05

The selected candidates will be invited to present their white paper in the Technical Conference or in the Exhibition Gallery at UrjaVarta 2025.
